### **VISITOR REGULATIONS**

#### **TICKETS**

Keep your ticket with you at all times until the end of your visit.

# **CHILDREN**

Please do not leave children unattended.

# **EXHIBITION**

It is prohibited to touch objects on display.

Please do not run, speak loudly or otherwise disturb visitors in the museum.

### **SECURITY**

Before entering the exhibition visitors will be asked to pass through the security post and submit their personal items for screening.

# **CLOAKROOM AND LOCKERS**

Coats, bags, umbrellas and other personal items must be left in the cloakroom or lockers. No valuables may be deposited. Museum does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage sustained by items deposited.

Please do not leave any items unattended. Such items may be removed by museum staff.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

It is permitted to photograph/film free of charge for personal use. Use of camera stands and flash is prohibited.

### **MOBILE PHONES**

Use of mobile phones and other sound emitting devices in the museum is prohibited.

### FOOD AND DRINK

Consumption of food and drink is not permitted in the museum except in the designated areas. Visitors may not bring food or drink into the exhibition.

It is prohibited to consume or bring in alcohol and other intoxicating substances. Visitors appearing intoxicated will not be admitted to the museum.

# **SMOKING**

Smoking is prohibited in the museum territory, including the courtyard.

# ANIMALS

No animals may be brought into the museum territory.

#### **BICYCLES**

Visitors with bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters are not permitted to enter the museum territory.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

It is prohibited to bring in guns, knives and other dangerous objects into the museum territory.

# **ENFORCEMENT**

Museum staff are authorised to require compliance with visitor regulations. Visitors violating the regulations will be asked to leave the premises.
